00724	Introduction to Arabic Linguistics V 2st, Mo 18-20, S 90 BA Kultur und Gesellschaft, Modul ARA SW I.1	Serreli
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The course is offered in English.

This course introduces basic linguistic principles in the field of phonology and morphology, with a focus on Modern Standard Arabic. The course provides an introduction to methodological and analytical tools for the linguistic study of Arabic and is recommended to students who have successfully passed (at least) Intensive Arabic 1.

Active participation is recommended.

00725	Arabic Sociolinguistics V 2st, Di 10-12, S 90 BA Kultur und Gesellschaft, Modul ARA SW III, Kombifach AISK, Modul C2	Serreli
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The course is offered in English.

The course is an introduction to Arabic sociolinguistics. Key sociolinguistic concepts, as standard and prestige language, diglossia and multilingualism, language and identity, are discussed with reference to the Arabic case. Selected cases will be analyzed in detail.

00324	Introduction to Arabic Dialectology V 2st, Do 16-18, S 90 BA Kultur und Gesellschaft, Modul ARA SW II, Kombifach AISK, Modul C2	Serreli
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The course is offered in English.

The course introduces the basic principles of Arabic dialectology and the basic features of Arabic dialects. The geographical varieties of Arabic will be presented and the more prominent linguistic features of selected varieties will be analyzed in detail. The course is recommended to students who have successfully passed 'Gesprochenes Arabisch 1' and are in their 4th semester.

00002	(Socio)Linguistic fieldwork in the Arab world V 2st, Mi 10-12, S 90 BA Kultur und Gesellschaft, Mobilitätsfenster Modul ARA SW II, MA SprInK Modul M6.1, M6.2	Serreli
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The course is offered in English.

The course will provide an overview on methods and techniques in (socio)linguistic research and discuss the appropriateness of research methods and techniques according to the research design. The course prepares the students to undertake linguistic fieldwork as it provides practical information and training about the phases of research design and data collection and analysis. Particular attention will be devoted to research in the Arab world, to prepare students to approach the study of contemporary Arabic varieties and the context where they are spoken.

00351	A typological approach to Arabic in Africa S 2 hpw, Tuesday, 16-18, from 10 May 2022 in room S 90, before that online	Owens
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The course is offered in English. The initial lecture will be via zoom.

Arabic is the largest native language in Africa. It is also marked by a large degree of internal variation whose origins have yet to be explored systematically. As a precursor to addressing the issue of historical origins it is necessary to offer an overview of the structural typology of the different varieties of Arabic in Africa. This course will offer concise but comprehensive summaries of the important phonological, morphological and lexical elements which characterize the various dialects. It will treat the following dialectal areas: Egypt (different dialects), the eastern Sudan and the Nile, western Sudanic Arabic, North Africa (divided among Mauretania, Morocco, Algeria and Tunisia) and eastern Libya. If time allows, Maltese and Andalusian Arabic will be studied as well.
