Prerequisite: the course has no prerequisites. First-semester students are warmly encouraged to attend.

The course is an introduction to the study of the Arabo-Islamic world, in its multiplicity. The lectures will cover the following topics: history of the North-African and Middle Eastern region (MENA) and its modern and contemporary politics; rise and development of Islam and its current practice; the people and languages found in the region and the sociocultural elements characterizing the different communities; the literary and artistic production. The course will be offered in English and host invited speakers. A detailed syllabus will be announced in October 2020.
